

MINUTES OF THE WEST SANDY COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

The meeting was opened with a call to order by Joe McDaniel, President. He welcomed each one present and asked Velma Bruce to lead the prayer.

The minutes of the July 27, 2006 meeting were read by Joyce Shiflet, Secretary. Margaret White motioned to accept the minutes as read. Dennis Hosea seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Judy Ellington, Treasurer, read the treasury report. Velma Bruce motioned to accept the report as read. Cal Webster seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Old Business: Charles Bobbitt announced that a window in the School House was repaired by the window company. He reported a need to wait for the inmates to return until he can finish his work at the church in Houston. When work begins again on the School House, painting will be done and a handrail will be built. Delma Shelly and Margaret White are to select kitchen counter and floor covering. Mike Cockcroft, local builder, has offered to bury the trash on the premises. The inmates are to clean fence rows and the yard.

Delma Shelly gave a report from the committee to establish rules for use of the School House. The cost to use it for events other than WSCA activities will be \$100 per day. A \$50 advance deposit must be paid and will be returned within ten days after the event, providing the facility is properly cleaned after the event. The rules as suggested will be refined and presented at a later date to be voted on.

Mary Webster will be responsible for keeping a calendar of outside events/rentals.

Delma reported she has had only one response to her request for insurance quotes. That was from Allstate and was in the amount of \$1,940.53. Cal and Mary Webster will pay the first year's insurance premium.

Margaret White reported on the flooring materials she had found. A suggestion was made that vinyl sheet flooring be installed in the two side-by-side rooms, ceramic tile in both bathrooms and wood floors in the hall and auditorium.
