

## MARCH 24TH MEETING

The initial meeting of the reactivated West Sandy Community Association was held at 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, March 24, 2005 at the Ebenezer Baptist Church. Evelyn McDaniel, Bobby Wells and invited guest, James Patton, presided over the meeting. In summary, the events of the meeting were as follows: After Bobby Wells opened the meeting, Evelyn McDaniel explained the events leading up to the proposed preservation of the San Jacinto School House (SJSH) and the necessity for the reactivation of the West Sandy Community Association (WSCA), as owner of the SJSH property. James Patton presided over the business of the meeting. Nominations were held for the Board of Trustees and the following Trustees were elected: Evelyn McDaniel, Bobby Ellington, Buddy Hosea, Mike Bruce and Velma Bruce. The regular meeting date of the 3rd Thursday of each month was voted on and passed. Evelyn McDaniel discussed the need for volunteers to monitor security in light of recent vandalism at the SJSH and !

Buddy Hosea volunteered to head up such a committee. The building of a pipe fence around the SJSH was proposed and explained by Joe McDaniel, who offered materials to complete the job. Evelyn McDaniel announced tentative plans for a clean-up day at SJSH on Saturday, May 7, 2005 at 9:00 a.m. The possibility of organized groups to clean-up prior to May 7, as available, was discussed. Evelyn McDaniel asked the Board of Trustees to remain after the meeting for further discussion. No other business was discussed and the meeting was adjourned.
