**MINUTES**  
**MEETING OF THE**  
**WEST SANDY COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION**  
**September 29, 2005**

The regular monthly meeting of the West Sandy Community Association was held at the Ebenezer Baptist Church, Huntsville, TX, on September 29, 2005, at 6:30 p.m. The meeting originally scheduled for September 22, 2005 was postponed until this date due to the threat of Hurricane Rita.

The meeting was called to order and Joe McDaniel, President, welcomed members and gave the benediction.

Neither the Secretary nor the Treasurer was present at the meeting, so the minutes from the meeting of August 25, 2005 and the current treasurer's report were not read.

Dennis Hosea gave a brief report of the ongoing repair of the sagging floors and ceiling in the School House auditorium and the securing and stabilizing of the exterior walls which was initiated on Saturday, September 17, by Robert ~~Elison~~ and Dennis Hosea.

Mike Bruce advised that the TDCJ would need to know <sup>Ellington</sup> exactly what we need done in order to commit to provide labor for repair or construction of the School House.

Joe McDaniel reported that Robert Bruner and Danny Pierce have donated \$300 each to cover the cost to initiate water service from the Walker County Water District. Dennis Hosea agreed to submit the necessary documentation and payment to the Water District. The donations of Mr. Bruner and Mr. Pierce will be deposited in our restoration bank account and a check will be written from that account made payable to the Water District.

Margaret White discussed the details of her plans for the "Ol' Fashioned Chicken Chowder Supper" fundraiser event to be held at the School House grounds on Saturday, October 8, 2005, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Margaret requested four additional volunteers to provide decorated box desserts to be auctioned off. Discussion was had regarding the provision of chairs, tables, a guest registration book, receipts for donations, and a sign at the School House site advertising the event. Joe McDaniel offered to make a sign and he and Jim Woods agreed to transport tables to and from the Farris Chapel Church to the School House site. Chairs will be identified and borrowed from the Ebenezer Baptist Church. Alternative arrangements in case of inclement weather on October 8 were discussed. It was agreed that Jim Woods will make temporary repairs to the floors in the hallway and that the auditorium of the School House will be cordoned off to prohibit entry to that room due to the removal of floorboards by vandals.

The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, October 27.

**There being no further business before the meeting, on motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned.**
